Additional project data: The project has 2.8 km of the riverbed for dredging, with a recharge capacity of 1,968,463 m³ /year of drag material; located in a macro-focalized area for gold concentration, in the alluvial fan where drag materials are deposited by the San Francisco and Chuare rivers, improving the dredging projection during the life of the project.
